Meeting called to order at 9:05AM

Minutes of 6/14/12 were read and accepted as amended.

Changes in the minutes were: The location of the second tree is at the end of the stone wall between the North and main sections of #3.

The wording of the vote to change the definition of boundary markers now reads:

The owner will have four 4X4X6" granite corner posts paced flush to the ground as marked by the Sexton to the dimensions of the owners lot. This must be done as soon as possible after the purchase of the lot.

Treasurer's report:

Lohmiller's bill for \$180.00 and Miller's bill for for \$128.45, were paid out of Cemetery Repairs(4195-36).

The annual membership dues were paid out of Prof. Develop. 4195-07

\$476.90 was transferred from the GMTF to the Perpetual Care account, bringing those accounts up to date.

Robblee's bill for \$750.00 was paid by the GMTF.

3. Denise Buzzell, and the need to approach her about the lot in Cemetery #3
4. Still on the docket is getting the wording for an ad for reclaiming a lot.
