Minutes of Meeting April 10, 2010

Minutes of the February meeting were approved and accepted after the addition that there was no meeting in March due to Town Meeting.

Maureen asked members to suggest the names of people who may be interested in joining the Commission. Betsy Hardwick will be the Selectmen's representative.

It was reported that there are two properties on Dennison Pond Rd. under consideration for tower sites.

Frank Hanchett has agreed to do a mill site tour on June 5th and will make an agenda. The tour will be titled "Mill Walk About".

There was no discussion regarding Main St. lighting from the Selectmen. There is a Town Lights Committee to help resolve the issue. Maureen will ask Sarah Pyle if the Heritage Commission can be of help. There is a meeting on lighting April 14th.

Maureen explained the breakdown of the Commission's budget. Disbursement of monies received by the Commission will be their responsibility.

Thank you letters, recognizing retiring members of the Commission, are being sent.

There is no information yet from the National Preservation Trust regarding the Town Hall.

There is no meeting today of the Town Hall Study Group because of scheduling conflict.

Maureen was able to attend NH Preservation Alliance Seminar and shared some of the information that she received.

The Commission's next meeting will be May 9th.
