1/11/2016 – 1/17/2016

1. On 1/11 at 1121 received a report of a single motor vehicle collision on Bible Hill Road extension. The investigation determined that the driver was operating northbound on Bible Hill Road extension when the vehicle lost control and left the roadway striking a tree. The operator was identified as Kyle M. Charbonneau, age 17 of Bible Hill Road Extension in Fracestown. The vehicle was towed from the scene. The operator did not sustain any injuries. The collision is still under investigation by the Fracestown Police Department.
2. On 1/14 at 1104 Fracestown police observed suspicious activity at 235 Sky Farm Road residence in Deering while on routine patrol. The information pertaining to the suspicious vehicle and operator was forwarded onto Deering Police for further investigation.
3. On 1/14 at 1449 received a report of a motor vehicle complaint of a specific vehicle that had passed a school bus on Bennington Road that was headed southbound. State Police notified.
4. On 1/16 at 0131 received a report of a motor vehicle collision where a vehicle slid off the roadway on Bennington Road and struck a parked vehicle. No injuries reported and State Police notified.
5. On 1/16 at 0824 received a report of a motor vehicle collision involving two vehicles on Bennington Road north of Pleasant Pond with no injuries. Upon arrival it was determined that the operator of vehicle # 1 was one Anthony Bailey, age 35 of Schoolhouse Road in Fracestown NH and the operator of vehicle # 2 was one Kevin Tronkowski, age 46 of Noons Quarry Road in Milford NH. It was determined that vehicle # 1 (2010 Chevrolet pickup) was southbound when the operator last control and traveled into the northbound lane, colliding with vehicle # 2 (2012 Lexus 4 door). The investigation indicated that the contributing factors of the collision were, the operator of vehicle # 1 was operating the vehicle with defective equipment and road surface conditions were reduced.

6. On 1/16 at 1038 received a report for mutual aid to Bennington PD for a vehicle that was southbound on Bennington Road towards Frankestown and was refusing to stop. The vehicle was ultimately stopped and Bennington PD addressed the situation.
7. On 1/17 at 0414 from a resident on Wilson Hill Road for a suspicious vehicle complaint. State Police notified.
8. On 1/17 at 2128 received a report of a vehicle off the roadway with no injuries in the area of 1163 New Boston Road. State Police notified.
