1/18/2016 – 1/25/2016

1. On 1/19 at 0058 received a report of a disturbance at 125 Pleasant Pond Road. State Police notified.
2. On 1/19 at 1043 responded to a residence of 2nd New Hampshire Turnpike for a report of suspicious activity on the evening of 1/18. Contact made with the reporting party at the residence and the investigation is on-going.
3. On 1/19 at 1659 responded to the area of Wilson Hill Road for a report of suspicious person appearing at the front of a residence. The Fracestown, Deering and Bennington Police Departments responded and arrived within seven (7) minutes. It was reported that an unknown suspect was looking in the window by the front door and then moved away from the door area. Described the suspect as a male. No suspect was located in the immediate area. Investigation is continuing into the matter.
4. On 1/19 at 1734 the Fracestown Police Department responded to a single motor vehicle collision on Old County Road north. Upon arrival the vehicle had been was being operated eastbound on Old County Road north when it left the roadway, veering over an embankment and coming to final rest on the passenger side of the vehicle. The operator was identified as one Stephanie Pelkey, age 20 of Hillsborough NH. At the time of the collision there were two passengers in the vehicle and the occupants were not seriously injured. The investigation into the causation factor of the collision is on-going.
5. On 1/21 at 1341 received residential alarm activation on Poor Farm Road. State Police advised of the alarm.
6. On 1/22 at 0325 received a call on Bennington Road for a medical emergency involving a 69 year old male. Fracestown Rescue responded to the scene and assisted the victim.
