Press Release

10/19/2015 – 10/25/2015

1. On 10/19 at 2131 received complaint of power outage and tree down in area of 12 School House Road. Keene Mutual Aid advised and Fracestown Fire Department responded.
2. On 10/20 at 1035 responded to 36 Gerrish Road for a citizen assist.
3. On 10/20 at 1329 while Fracestown Police were conducting routine patrol located a single vehicle motor vehicle collision on Birdsall Road. Vehicle was a 2001 Subaru operated by a William A. Chambers, age 18 of Fracestown, NH. Investigation conducted and indicated that the operator was traveling northbound on Birdsall Road when the vehicle lost control traveling into the southbound lane, leaving the roadway striking three (3) trees against the passenger side of said vehicle. The vehicle continued and came to rest upon an adjacent stonewall. There were no injuries to the operator. Vehicle sustained severe damage to the bumper, passenger door and undercarriage. Vehicle was towed from the scene. Causation of the accident was determined to be inattention by the operator.
4. On 10/20 at 1714 received a report of a medical emergency to the area of Pleasant Pond Road. Emergency services responded.
5. On 10/20 at 1738 received a report of a motor vehicle complaint that was operating erratically from Russell Station Road towards 2nd NH Turnpike. Mont Vernon and Lyndeborough Police department were advised.
6. On 10/22 at 1056 received a call from a citizen in the area of 979 Greenfield Road indicating that she is missing a female tiger cat. Information recorded.
7. On 10/22 at 1516 received a report for a medical emergency on Pleasant Pond road for an 89 year old male that was unresponsive. Emergency services responded.
8. On 10/23 at 1444 received a report of a disabled motor vehicle in the area of Old County Road and Route 136. Upon arrival spoke with operator and was assisted in getting the vehicle started. Cleared.
9. On 10/24 at 1832 received a report of a suspicious vehicle in the area of New Boston Road. Vehicle was described as being a black colored pickup. A license plate was obtained and the investigation is continuing. No criminal activity was reported by the complainant.
10. On 10/25 at 1302 received a report of a medical call on Poor Farm Road. Emergency services assisted.
11. On 10/25 at 2106 received a report of alarm activation on Dodge Hill Road. Prior to arrival the owner cancelled the response.
