PRESS RELEASE

6/15/2015 – 6/21/2015

1. On 6/15 @ approximately 0830 received a report of a nuisance canine barking in the area of 82 Clarksville Road in the late evening and early morning hours. Further investigation indicated that this has been an on-going issue for some time. The accused, Christina Dubuque of 82 Clarksville Road was contacted and given advice on how to correct the issue along with a final warning.
2. On 6/16 @ 1235 received a report of livestock in the roadway on Bible Hill Road. Responded to the area and assisted the owners in the removal of same.
3. On 6/17 @ 1836 received a report to respond to the area of South New Boston Road for a report of an eighteen year old subject threatening suicide. Fracestown and Greenfield officers along with members of the Fracestown Rescue Department responded to the location and assisted family members and the party of concern.
