PRESS RELEASE

7/6/2015 – 7/12/2015

1. On 7/6 @ 1700 responded to 130 Chandler Road for a domestic violence investigation. Investigation initiated and both involved parties were counseled relative to the complaint. Cleared
2. On 7/6 @ 1805 responded to area of 130 Chandler Road for a report of a single motor vehicle collision with no personal injury. Upon arrival it was determined that the operator, Amy MacDonald, age 45 was operating a 2003 Ford Victoria sedan along Chandler Road when she lost control and came to final rest in a ditch area. Further investigation indicated that the operator was allegedly under the influence and was subsequently arrested for driving while intoxicated. Defendant was bailed in the amount of \$1,000.00 PR and an arraignment date has been set for July 23, 2015 in the Goffstown District Court.
3. On 7/7 @ 1252 served Stalking Petition out of the Goffstown District Court. Cleared without further incident.
4. On 7/7 @ 1407 responded to the area of 245 Reid Road for a report of shots being fired. Complainant reported that it was occurring close to her residence. Investigation indicated that the discharge of the firearm was not near the complainant's residence. Cleared without incident.
5. On 7/7/ @ 1636 responded to 130 Chandler Road for a civil stand-by. Cleared without further incident.
6. On 7/8 @ 1544 responded to 130 Chandler Road relative to a civil issue, delivered message and cleared without further incident.

7. On 7/9/ @ 0900 received a complaint of a trailer parked in the travel portion of the roadway on Pleasant Pond Road. Upon arrival located the trailer with NH Trailer Plate number T142017 expired 2/2006 parked partially on the travel portion of the roadway. Investigation indicated that the trailer was a hazard to other vehicles. The owner was identified and contacted through a third party. Third party was advised that it could not be parked upon the roadway in the manner it was found. Police Department removed the trailer by manually pushing it back into the driveway adjacent to where it was located. Cleared without further incident.
8. On 7/11 @ 1211 received a call to respond to 85 Oak Hill Road for a report of criminal threatening investigation. The victim of the criminal threatening was at this residence and wanted to report the incident. Investigation is on-going.
9. On 7/11 @ 1627 received call for two canines running at large at 53 New Boston Road / Route 136. Reporting person indicated that this was an on-going issue with these canines. The animal control officer was advised and would address the issue.
