1/26/2016 – 1/31/2016

1. On 1/27 at 1230 received a complaint of discharging of a firearm in the area of Muzzey Road. Upon arrival it was undetermined if this was occurring in this area. Cleared.
2. On 1/27 at 1308 received a report of an attempted fraud on Campbell Hill Road. The investigation indicated that a caller had contacted the homeowner and said they represented the Publishing Clearing House. They further stated they had won a certain amount of cash and a new vehicle. Through the investigation by this agency certain facts obtained indicated that it was probable that this was a telephone type of fraud and scam. Case forwarded to the New Hampshire Attorney General's Office for review.
3. On 1/27 at 1322 received a report of a vehicle passing another vehicle on Route 47 in Bennington and continuing into Fracestown. This agency was unable to make contact because of a different investigation that was taking place.
4. On 1/27 at 2346 received a complaint that a vehicle had gone off the roadway on Old County Road North. The caller stated that there was no damage or injuries to the occupants and the vehicle would be towed. Information only so it would not be towed by law enforcement.
5. On 1/29 at 1401 received a report from the New Boston police department that a vehicle had been reported traveling on New Boston Road and the operator may have been intoxicated. Upon checking this area in New Boston they notified this agency. State Police notified.
6. On 1/30 at 2247 received a report of a vehicle off the roadway in the area of Crotched Mountain Resort. Complainant stated that she was stuck. Bennington Police responded and assisted the complainant.
7. On 1/31 at 1940 received a call for a medical emergency on Pleasant Pond Road. Emergency services responded and assisted the victim.
